

INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY

Safety is the first priority for Race on the River 2023. The organizers and officials of Race on the River 2023 reserve the right to delay or cancel any or all races due to inclement weather, including thunder, lightning, high winds (causing waves) or any other weather condition which may impact the safety of persons involved in the races. Thunder and lightning pose a significant danger, particularly on open water.

In the event of active weather in the area, races will be delayed for as long as necessary to ensure the safety of all participants. If such delays prove extensive and it is not possible to conduct all scheduled races, the grand final races will be cancelled in favour of completing the balance of the race schedule. In such circumstances, the *Sobeys Cup*, the *Bruce F. Murray Memorial Cup* and the *Advocate Printing Cup* will be awarded based on the average times posted by those teams which otherwise would have competed in the grand final races.
