HOW TO MAKE UP A TEAM

A full Dragon Boat team consists of ***16 Paddlers and 1 Drummer.*** Teams may include up to 4 alternates. A qualified coxswain is provided by the event. **Minimum age for participation is 16 years of age (with parental consent).**

Each team must have a designated Team Captain and a Pledge Captain. You may also want to designate a Co-Captain to assist the Team Captain.
