HOW TO MAKE UP A TEAM

Race on the River is a participation level event for teams wanting to participate for the fun and excitement of Dragon Boating.

All Dragon Boat teams will consist of **16 Paddlers and 1 Drummer.** (the number has been limited due for safety reasons).

All teams must include at least **6 female paddlers.**

Teams may include up to **4 alternates** in case someone can't make it.

A qualified coxswain is provided by the event. *Minimum age for participation is 16 years of age (with parental consent).* **Only** Breast Cancer Dragon Boat teams will be allowed to consist of 20 Paddlers and 1 Drummer.

Each team must have a designated Team Captain and a Pledge Captain. You may also want to designate a Co-Captain to assist the Team Captain.

THE EVENT

Throughout the day races and off-water activities will entertain spectators and participants along the Riverfront. Sunday will be a day hosted by Women Alike.

Race on the River will once again be held on the East River, just one block from New Glasgow's Downtown shopping area.

HOW TO PAY AND WHERE TO MAIL

Non-Refundable Entry fee: \$650.00 to be paid by cheque or bank draft only. No Cash Accepted.

IMPORTANT: If your team is **registered** and **paid in FULL** by **May 1, 2020** you will be eligible for a chance to win your **TEAM REGISTRATION ENTRY FEE FREE.**

All teams must to be registered by June 5, 2020 to participate this year.

Fee includes one practice session and a minimum of two races. Registration is on a **first paid, first in** basis. Registration fees go toward operating costs.
