THE EVENT

Race on the River 2014 is a one-and-a half-day festival. Our 13th Annual Dragon Boat Festival opens Friday night with celebration and entertainment. Races begin Saturday morning. Throughout the day races and off-water activities will entertain spectators and participants along the Riverfront.

Race on the River will once again be held on the East River, just one block from New Glasgow's Downtown shopping area.

HOW TO MAKE UP A TEAM

Race on the River is a participation level event for teams wanting to participate for the fun and excitement of Dragon Boating. **All teams must include at least 8 female paddlers.**

A full Dragon Boat team consists of **24 people: 20 paddlers, 1 drummer, and 3 alternates.** A qualified coxswain is provided by the event. Minimum age for participation in the Saturday races is **16 years of age.**

Each team must have a designated Team Captain and a Pledge Captain. You may also want to designate a Co-Captain to assist the Team Captain.
